



John Singer Sargent was the most successful portrait painter of his era. During his career, he created roughly 900 oil paintings and more than 2000 watercolors, as well as countless sketches and charcoal drawings. His worldwide travels included Venice to the Tyrol, Corfu, the Middle East, Montana, Maine and Florida. Although Sargent was an American expatriate, he returned to the United States many times, often to answer the demand for commissioned portraits. Many of his most important works are in museums in the United States. He even stayed in Marietta, Georgia.
